

What is DISNEYPLUS.COM on My Bank Statement?

DISNEYPLUS.COM or **DISNEY+** is a billing label for Disney's streaming subscription service. It shows up when you've signed up for a Disney+ plan or a bundle that includes Hulu or ESPN+.

Why Am I Being Charged by Disney+?

Common reasons include:

- Disney+ monthly or annual subscription
- Disney Bundle (Disney+, Hulu, and ESPN+)
- In-app purchase through Roku, Apple, or Google

What is Disney+?

Disney+ is a streaming platform offering content from Disney, Pixar, Marvel, Star Wars, National Geographic, and more. It offers standalone plans and bundles with Hulu and ESPN+.

Is the Disney+ Charge Legit?

Most likely. Log into your account at disneyplus.com or check the app store associated with your device to view and manage your subscription.

How to Cancel a Disney+ Subscription

You can cancel by:

- Logging into Disney+ and visiting **Account > Subscription**
- Or using your device's app store subscription settings

It's a recurring charge for a Disney+ streaming subscription or bundle.

How do I stop Disney+ from charging me?

Log into your Disney+ account or device app store to cancel your subscription.
