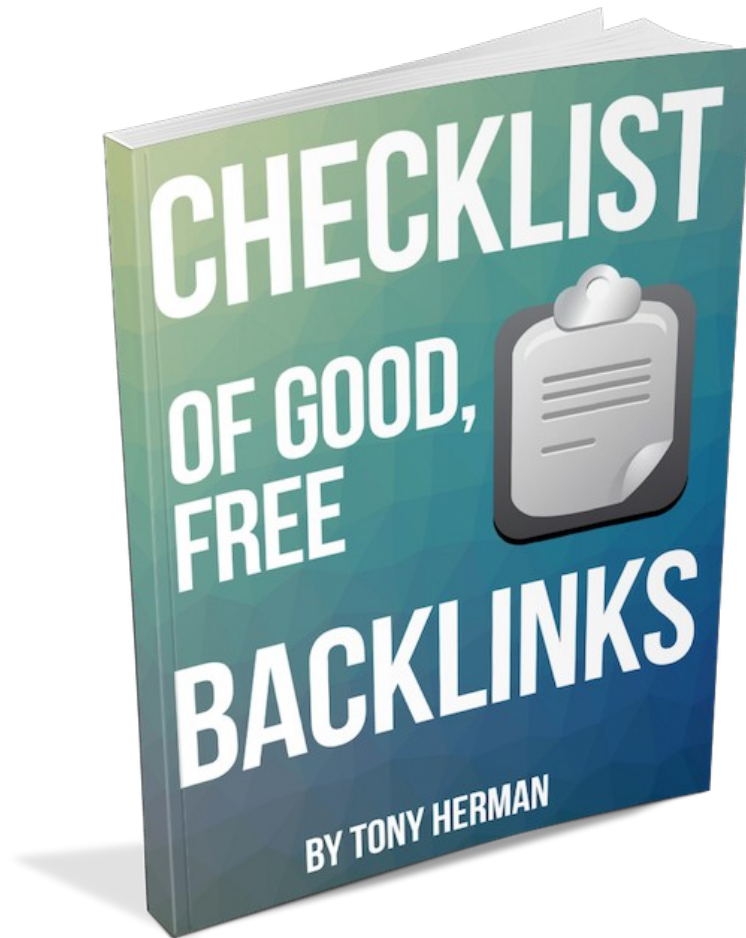


Checklist of Good, FREE Backlinks

A Word About Getting Backlinks

With great power, comes great responsibility, right? Well, it's not quite like that but the main thing is to be careful. Don't build links too quickly but do it gradually or else Google will see lots of new links and think it's unnatural and there's a good chance your website could start falling in rankings or even get de-listed until you get things cleaned up.

Speaking of that, here's one, very good strategy to use. Set up a subdomain of your main domain name and send new links there. That domain will then redirect to your main domain name.

OK, so for example, let's say `yourdomain.com` is your domain name. You should have your website show up either under the domain name or your "www" subdomain, which would be `www.yourdomain.com` in this case. Yes, the "www." part is a subdomain of the main domain name. Make sure one of these redirects to the other and make sure your website does not show up under both – meaning, when the page stops loading, look at the address in the browser address bar. One should redirect to the other and putting in both versions should not work.

A shorter domain is usually preferable, so if you have to make this decision, then go with the non-www version. If you already have the www version working and it's the only one that your website shows up under, don't go and change it, just leave it.

Now that we have that basic step out of the way, set up another subdomain like "web.yourdomain.com" or maybe "x.yourdomain.com" it really doesn't matter what it is but I wouldn't use "www" as the subdomain you'll be sending your new links to because that's a subdomain you have that's active. The idea here is that you can turn off a new subdomain if you have to – if the links you've built.

Here's a summary:

<code>yourdomain.com</code>	your main website
<code>www.yourdomain.com</code>	redirected subdomain
<code>web.yourdomain.com</code>	redirected subdomain for link building

Like I mentioned, you can build links to the "web" version and if for some reason you need to disavow or not have those links go to your main website, it's easy to turn it off.

With the "web" version, all you need hosted there is a `.htaccess` file (plain text file on Linux hosting) with this line in it (where "yourdomain.com" is your website's domain name, of course):

Redirect 301 /index.html https://yourdomain.com

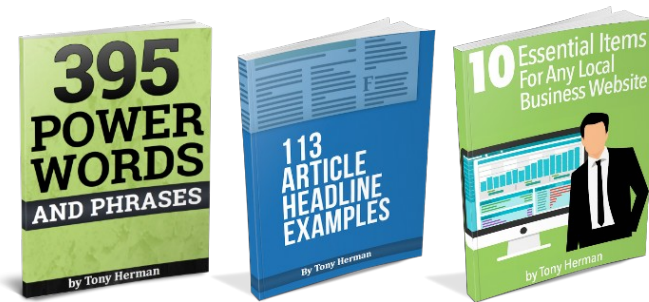
